# MINUTES

## SARA Meeting Minutes November 1st 2024

Meeting called to order by KB9KC at 7:00PM with introductions by 15 members and 1 guest who had successfully completed testing.

**Secretary Report:** Motion made by Darrell N9JOD and seconded by Fred AA9FS to accept the secretary's report as printed in the SARA Slip. Motion passed

**Treasurer Report:** Motion made by Steve WA9SWW and seconded by Thom W9RY to accept the treasurer's report as printed in The SARA Slip. Motion passed

**Repeater Committee Report:** Leroy KB9JNO stated that as of meeting time all repeaters were working ok.

Leroy also mentioned that there will be some testing in the future to try to resolve some interference issues at the 147.090 repeater site.

**Skywarn Report:** Kenny KB9KC mentioned the mild weather we have been having and his records show that on this date last year the low temperature was 25 degrees.

**Old Business:** Bob N9VKO reported that the communications support went well this year at the Mardi Gras parade on October 26, The weather was great and no emergency traffic had to be handled/passed. The parade was mostly clear of any gaps due to the repositioning of the 50/50 ticket selling crew and support wagon.

Bob N9VKO stated the he still had some volunteer T-shirts from The Shawnee 100 for volunteers who did not receive them.

Bruce WA9APQ asked all present to make up a list of items that would be needed if you found yourself in the same situation as those people in North Carolina to provide communications from your home to stations elsewhere to get aid where it is needed.

Jake KD9ZPK spoke briefly about using digital/wires-x repeaters and sending text messages to and from a cell phone through the radio/repeater system.
