Minutes SARA Meeting January 5th 2024

Skywarn Report: Kenny KB9KC announced that there will be training coming up soon, with one taking place on Monday March 5th at The University of Illinois Extension office in Benton Illinois and at the Williamson County fire station in Marion from 9:00AM to 12:00PM on March 16th. ARES : WA9APQ stated that an Auxcom class will be held in Mt. Vernon on Feb 3-4. it will be hosted by Jefferson County EMA.
