MINUTES

SARA Meeting Minutes June 4th 2021

Meeting called to order by Kenny KB9KC at 7:00PM with 12 members present.

Secretary Report : Motion made by Ed KD9FRQ and seconded by Shawn K9PWW to accept the minutes of the last meeting as printed in The SARA Slip. Motion passed.

Treasurer's Report: Motion made by Leroy KB9JNO and seconded by Buddy K9BJA to accept the treasurer's report as printed in the SARA Slip. Motion passed.

Repeater Committee Report: Leroy KB9JNO reported that a new Yeasu Fusion repeater had been ordered to replace the aging 146.880 SCAN repeater on the linked 147.090/146.880 linked system and a new radio had been ordered for the link system.

Skywarn Report: Kenny KB9KC stated that net control help is needed for the skywarn nets on Sunday evenings as 2 net control stations have become unavailable due to work hours conflicting. Those present were reminded about the 1-2 second delay in the linked repeater system in order for all radios used in that system can reset the timeout timer and key up again. Listen for the courtesy beep to acknowledge that the timeout timer has been reset before pressing the microphone key.

Old Business: Kenny KB9KC stated that the once again communications support has been requested for The Shawnee Hills 100 Race to be held on August 28-29 with the same race course being used. Kenny asked that if you are interested in helping contact him by e-mail at kenkb9kc@gmail.com.

Tom also mentioned to everyone that the FCC has volunteers monitoring local repeaters and simplex frequencies to report any possible illegal activity so be sure to use your call sign as stated in the FCC rules.
