# MINUTES

SARA Meeting Minutes May 6th 2022

Meeting called to order by Kenny KB9KC at 7:00PM with 18 members and 1 guest present.

**Announcements:** Tom W9RY stated that the F.C.C. \$35.00 fee is supposed to be in effect right now but Amateur Radio licenses are being issued without payment of the fee due to computer problems at the F.C.C. Office. Newly licensed Amateur Radio Operators may receive a notice later to pay the fee. If the new licensee is under 18 years of age the fee will be reimbursed after submitting a request for to the ARRL. Those candidates who under 18 will also only pay a \$5.00 testing fee rather than the \$15.00 normal fee. Tom W9RY stated that he will be ARRL Illinois Section Manager for 2 more years.

**Secretary Report :** Motion made by Steve WA9SWW and seconded by Gerry WG9Z to accept the minutes of the last meeting as printed in The SARA Slip. Motion passed.

**Treasurer's Report:** Motion made by Tom W9RY and seconded by Scott KC9AJR to accept the treasurer's report as printed in the SARA Slip. Motion passed.

**Repeater Committee Report:** Bruce WA9APQ stated that after club approval to purchase a back-up DRX2 Yaesu Fusion repeater the price had gone up from \$700.00 to \$1800 and suggested that the purchase could be delayed until the price may go back down.

Bruce WA9APQ gave a report on the progress of moving the 146.640 repeater to Herrin and checking the feed line on the tower to see if replacement is required or not.

**Skywarn Report:** Kenny KB9KC reminded everyone that if you don't check in for 3 weeks in row your call sign will be removed from the roll call list but can be added back on at any point in time when you are able to check in again.

**Old Business:** Bob N9VKO stated that everything went pretty well at the River To River Relay after 2 years of no race with two lost runners being found and some road rage by local residents in

Pope County. Several others present shared their stories as well.

Kenny KB9KC reminded everyone that the once again communications support has been requested for the Shawnee Hills 100 Race to be held on August 27-28 with the same race course being used. Kenny asked that if you are interested in helping contact him by e-mail at kenkb9kc@gmail.com.

**New Business :** Tom W9RY spoke about the ARRL grant program for radio clubs that is available for local community based ham radio activities. The grant money can not be used in the same way as a fund raiser for a radio club. Check the ARRL web site for more details.
