February 7st 2020

Repeater Committee Report: Leroy KB9JNO reported that 146.640 repeater has been working fine and the noise problem on the 147.090 repeater still remains an on and off thing that makes it very difficult to track down. Bruce WA9APQ also stated that he and Leroy KB9JNO were getting closer to solving the problem but weren't there yet.

Skywarn Report: Kenny KB9KC reminded everyone that it is time again for Skywarn Spotter training. Check the schedule for a class nearest you and contact info at the Paducah National Weather Service web site. Tom W9RY stated that his web site has links to check the schedule. At meeting time no one was certain of the March date at John A. Logan College.
