# MINUTES

SARA Meeting Minutes February 5th 2021

Meeting called to order by KB9KC at 7:00PM with introductions by 15 members.

**Secretary Report:** None – N9VKO was not in attendance - no minutes of last ZOOM meeting recorded

**Treasurer Report:** Motion made by Tom W9RY and seconded by Gerry WG9Z to accept the treasurer's report as printed in The SARA Slip. Motion passed

**Repeater Committee Report:** Bruce WA9APQ reported that things seem to be working well at the 146.640 site and after the latest replacement of cans/cavities at the 147.090 repeater site there seems to be some noise once again but has not been heard for a few days as of meeting time.

**Skywarn Report:** Kenny KB9KC and Tom W9RY both stated that all Skywarn training is still on-line at this time due to Covid restrictions.

**Old Business:** Kenny spoke about Shawn K9PWW receiving some equipment from donations and grants for use by the club he has put together at school. It was mentioned that some of SK W9MXM Ray Melhorn;'s equipment may be donated to school amateur radio club by Ray's widow.

**New business:** W9RY stated that as of meeting time the F.C.C. has will be charging a \$35.00 fee for each new Amateur Radio License application or renewal.

SARA Slip Editor Fred AA9FS spoke about computer issues that are creating problems in sending the SARA by mail. Fred AA9FS proposed sending the Slip e-mail only. Members were advised to check with others who may not have e-mail to find out if they would like a printed copy and then print and send it to them.

Bruce WA9APQ mentioned that he had been contacted about the possibility of providing communications support for the Boy Scout's Last Scout standing event that will take place on the weekend of April 16-17. The support would be similar to The River to River Relay Race which will not take place again this year due to continuing Covid restrictions. Bruce was not sure at meeting time if the event would require that communications be provided both Saturday and Sunday. All interested should contact Bruce as soon as possible since the event

is not that far off.

Bob N9VKO suggested that if communications are provided for the Boy Scout event there be a communications coordinator for each day that the service is provided.

Bruce WA9APQ and Kenny KB9KC gave a health and welfare report on Tony KB9QZI

Tom W9RY stated that an earthquake exercise will take place on May 1st statewide. Tom also stated that the FCC is going to require that all ham radio license holders have an e mail address on file at the FCC. Your license could be lost if the FCC sends an e-mail message and gets no response from you.

A motion to have Field Day with SCAN at Glenn-O-Jones Lake was made by Gerry WG9Z seconded by Buddy K9BJA and passed.

Bruce WA9APQ informed all present that there will be an ARES net on the 15th of each month at 7:00PM in addition to the Sunday evening check-in net in order to do more activities on Illinois State frequencies.
