MINUTES

SARA Meeting Minutes April 1st 2022

Meeting called to order by Kenny KB9KC at 7:00PM with 19 members present.

Secretary Report : Motion made by Jim K9JIM and seconded by Leroy KB9JNO to accept the minutes of the last meeting as printed in The SARA Slip. Motion passed.

Treasurer's Report: Motion made by Ed KD9FRQ and seconded by Buddy K9BJA to accept the treasurer's report as printed in the SARA Slip. Motion passed.

Repeater Committee Report: Leroy KB9JNO reported that Saturday April 2nd the 147.090/690 and the 146.880/.280 repeaters will be replaced with new Yaesu Fusion repeaters. Both repeaters are expected to be back on air by late afternoon or early evening. Both performed well during testing. It was pointed out there will be no backup/spare repeater if a problem developed and the new repeaters are much more difficult to repair usually requiring sending them back to the factory. A motion was made by Tom W9RY and was seconded by Gerry WG9Z to purchase a spare/backup repeater. Motion passed

Bruce WA9APQ has been working with the Mayor of Herrin to work out plans to move the 146.640/040 repeater to a tower site that is no longer used by the Herrin Police Department and as of meeting time it seems to be possible. More details later

Skywarn Report: Tom W9RY stated that on-line Elite Storm Spotter training is coming up on April 12 at Mount Vernon those that are interested need to pre-register on the Paducah Kentucky NWS web site.

Old Business: Bob N9VKO gave an update on the April 23rd running of The Illinois River To River Relay Race and passed out the race information packets to those volunteers that were present.

Kenny KB9KC reminded everyone that The Shawnee Hills 100 will again be run this year on August 27-28 based at Camp Ondessonk . Kenny KB9KC stated that he will start sending out e-mails to start putting together the communications support team. Bruce WA9APQ spoke about the possibility of the race officials using chip timing for the runners.

New Business : Tom W9RY stated that as of April 19 the F.C.C. will begin charging a fee of \$35.00 for a new license, call sign change or renewal. There will be no charge to upgrade a license at this time.

Tom also mentioned that the youth licensing grant program is under development whereby the ARRL will pay the \$35.00 fee for a student under the age of 18 who gets a license. The VE testing fee for those individuals would be reduced to \$5.00 as well. It is still in the development stage at this time.

Tom W9RY spoke briefly about a grant program for Amateur Radio clubs for use in community based activities which could include Boy Scout and Girl Scout participation in Field Day.
