## SARA Meeting Minutes September 2nd 2022

Meeting called to order by Ken KB9KC at 7:00PM without introductions by members present as everyone knew each other.

Treasurer's Report: Printed in the SARA Slip. Motion to accept made by Ed KD9FRQ and seconded by Dan KC9CVN. Motion passed

Repeater Committee Report: Bruce WA9APQ stated that the 146.640 Herrin repeater was working ok and Leroy KB9JNO stated that the 147.090 linked repeater was working ok as well.

Skywarn Report: Tom W9RY stated that fall Skywarn training sessions were posted on The Paducah National Weather Service web site.

Old Business: Ken KB9KC stated that he would like to discuss payment of club dues at the October meeting. Tom W9RY reminded everyone that if ARRL dues are also renewed through the SARA Club, the club will receive five dollars from ARRL Ken spoke about The Shawnee 100 and made an apology for not keeping track of runner in and out times at the aid station where he was stationed. Ken stated that he had been told one of the race officials would be sending that info to Rich AB9S and Kelly N9KJB at Camp Ondessonk but it was only going to the scoring/race directors table at the start/finish line. Ken also apologized to the crew at station 6 who were supposed to have 2 porta-potties but did not receive them at all. Ken also stated that having 2 medically trained volunteers on the course, Dennis N9TAK and his son, was a good thing for the race.

Tom W9RY reported that ARRL has awarded \$270,000 dollars in radio club grants and will open up for applications in the fall for \$225,000 dollars of grants.

New Business : ED KD9FRQ stated that volunteers are needed for communications support of the upcoming Tunnel Hill 100 Race to be held on the second weekend of November. The request has been made due to spotty cell phone service along the race course Contact Rich

AB9S or Ed KD9FRQ if interested. This race is also a 2 day event with 7 aid stations.
