Meeting called to order by Ken KB9KC at 7:00PM with 19 members present

Skywarn Report: Kenny KB9KC stated that there will be a ZOOM training session training session for Net Control stations that will last about 90 minutes through DuPage County on September 18 starting at 7:00PM.
